



## *Weber Mosquito Abatement District*

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**The Board of Trustees of the Weber Mosquito Abatement District, Utah, met in public session August 9, 2021 at 6:00 pm., via Zoom. Meeting was called to order by Board Chair Steve Gibson. On roll call the following members were found to be present:**

Director Keith Hill, Trustees Dee Christoffersen, Max Ferre, and Ryan Barker were excused.

Bryan Baron, the District's Contract Attorney, was present.

**Welcome and Public Comment.** Board Chair Steve Gibson welcomed the Board of Trustees of the Weber Mosquito Abatement District to the August 9, 2021 Board Meeting. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Trustee Doug Stephens.

**Approval of the July 12, 2021 Board Meeting Minutes.** Trustee Bryon Saxton noted that he was not in attendance for the July 12, 2021 Board Meeting. Trustee Jim Harvey made a motion to approve the July 12, 2021 Board Meeting minutes with the correction on Trustee Bryon Saxton's attendance, motion seconded by Trustee Josh Blazzard. Motion passed unanimously.

**July Budget Report.** Assistant Director Taylor Anderson reviewed the Monthly Budget Report. General Fund Expenditures in July totaled \$195,755.57 with no additional expenses from Capital Expenditures. The Public Treasurer's Investment Fund balance is \$1,273,153.91. The Bank of Utah checking account balance as of July 30, 2021 totaled \$132,338.37. To date, the America First CD statement hasn't been received.

**Approval of the Monthly Bills for July.** The Board proceeded to discuss the monthly bills. Taylor explained check # 18547 totaling \$4481.16 to Kellerstrass Ent. for vehicle fuel, check # 18552 to Clarke Mosquito Control totaled \$40,650 for chemical, and check #18568 totaled \$2,342.54 to Rhinehart Oil (formerly Kellerstrass Ent.) for fuel. A motion to approve the monthly bills for July was made by Trustee Jim Harvey, seconded by Trustee David Smith. Motion passed unanimously.

**Director's Report:** Assistant Director Taylor Anderson presented Trustees with a Community Report. In July the District larvicided 89 acres on the ground, an additional 895 acres were treated by air, which includes 291 acres treated with the UAV. A total of 41,338 acres were adulticided on the ground, with and additional 33,920 treated by air. In July the District received a total of 94 spray requests, compared to 122 last year. Surveillance traps are operating on a regular basis. To date a total of 591 mosquito pools have been tested for WNV, five have tested positive for the virus.

The State of Utah has reported a total of 115 WNV positive mosquito pools and no human cases to date. CDC reports a total of 21 human West Nile Virus cases, which includes two deaths.

**Other Business:** Trustee David Smith encouraged the District to participate in the "Touch a Truck" event which is expected to take place Monday, August 30, 2021 at the West Haven City Building.

**Adjourn.** A motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Jim Harvey, seconded by Trustee Grover Wilhelmsen. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 6:40 pm.
